Thosaigh sé mar scéim trialach ach leis an t-éileamh agus an t-áthas a chruthaigh sé do dhaoine atá i mbun ceoil a fhoghlaím agus a sheinnt i measc daoine eile, ní raibh aon amhras orainn ach go mbeadh orainn leanúint leis an scéim mar chuid lárnach de chlár ealaíonta an Ionad Cultúrtha.

Tá a gcuid scileanna seinntte ceoil forbartha go mór ag ár gceoltóirí agus tá an-áthas orainn fáilte a chur an fómhar seo roimh 'Ensemble' ó Chill Mhantáin, atá ag tabhairt faoi scéim cosúil linn féin, agus atá chun bualadh lenár gceolaosaigh le haghaidh roinnt ceardlann agus ceolchoirm i dtreo deireadh an tséasúir. Is ábhar bróid dúinn é gur féidir linn ceangail cheoil a chruthú le grúpaí eile cosúil linn féin an t-am ar fad.

We are very proud of this scheme which is for the benefit of people over 55 and who wish to return to playing music. We started it as a trial run and due to the demand and the happiness it created for people returning to music, we decided to continue with this wonderful scheme as an integral part of our artistic program. Aithníonn an deis seo go mbíonn dúshláin roimh go leor ceoltóirí den chineál seo maidir le dul chun cinn gairme nach mbíonn ag ceoltóirí eile. Is é príomhchuspóir an chlár seo ná am agus spás a chur ar fáil do Cheoltóir Cónaithe chun a ngairm bheatha a fhorbairt. Residency opportunity

Applications are invited for the Music Network and Ionad Cultúrtha Musician-in-Residence Programme – a significant development opportunity specifically for a professional musician with Autism who has a strong track record in music performance.

This opportunity recognises that many such musicians face barriers toward career progression that others may not. The main purpose of the residency is to provide time and space for a Musician-in-Residence to develop their career intensively. We are seeking to make space for social change in the music sector in general and hope to learn from the Musician-in-Residence how we can better facilitate and include people with Autism in our own programmes and in the wider sector, both in performance and educational environments.

The Musician-in-Residence will receive a bursary of €8,000 and have access to a dedicated space during October and November 2025 to develop their creative practice and create new work and/or artistic collaborations. The musician will also engage with the community, working alongside an experienced facilitator to deliver a programme of inclusive music activities, and showcase their work live in concert at the end of the residency in November.

Last year's awardee Patrick Stefan was appointed as Musician-in-Residence at St. John's Theatre and Arts Centre. Patrick will perform a special concert featuring the world premiere of a new Irish language commission at the Ionad Cultúrtha to mark National Heritage Week on 22nd August.

To mark National Heritage Week, Music Network is delighted to present a very special concert by acclaimed musician and composer Patrick Stefan at the Ionad Cultúrtha, Baile Mhúirne.

Patrick Stefan (guitar/vocals) will be joined by Jayne Pomplas (fiddle) and Jason McNamara (percussion) for this unique performance, which will feature music composed by Patrick Stefan during his 2024 residency including settings of texts by John B. Keane and Barbara Derbyshire. In addition, there will be a world premiere of a new Music Network commission—an Irish language song, inspired by Baile Mhúirne and its rich cultural heritage.

Appointed Musician-in-Residence in 2024 by Music Network and St. John's Theatre and Arts Centre, Listowel, Patrick was the first artist to take part in a residency specifically designed for a professional musician who is Autistic/has Autism. In 2025, Music Network, in partnership with Ionad Cultúrtha, will launch the second edition of this important residency, which will take place in Baile Mhúirne during October and November.

Faigheann a cuid saothar inspiráid ó na tírdhreacha a mhúnlaigh í – an fharraige áit ina bhfuil cónaí anois uirthi, agus na crainn agus sléibhte mórrhimpeall ar Bhaile Mhúirne. Tá sí meallta isteach ag nithe nádúrtha ar nós fréamhacha, carraigearcha, agus an tstí ina fhágann an t-am a chuid rianta trí sraitheanna agus marcanna. Is minic go sníonn na gnéithe seo isteach ina cuid ealaíne, ní hamhán sna híomhánna ach sna dromchlaí féin chomh maith.

Forbraíonn sí uigeachtaí trí sraitheanna péint, uaireanta ag scríobadh siar nó ag athdhéanamh áiteanna ionas go bhfanann stair an tsaothair infheicthe. Eithne O'Riordan is a contemporary figurative and landscape painter from Baile Mhúirne, now based on the Dingle Peninsula.

Her work is inspired by the landscapes that have shaped her — the sea where she lives now, and the trees and mountains of Baile Mhúirne. She's drawn to natural forms like roots, rocks, and the way time leaves its traces through layers and marks. These elements often find their way into the paintings, not just in imagery but in the very surfaces themselves.

She builds up textures through layered paint, sometimes scraping back or reworking areas so the history of the piece stays visible. It's a process of both discovery and transformation, where each mark responds to the last. Eithne often works intuitively, beginning with a loose idea and allowing the painting to evolve organically.

Underlying it all is a sense of place — real or remembered — and an interest in how memory, emotion, and the natural world intertwine. Always looking to capture something just beneath the surface — a feeling, a tension, or a trace of magic in the everyday.

Caoimhín Ó Ragħallaiġ makes music on a 10-string fiddle called the hardanger d'amore.

He has performed on some of the most beautiful stages in the world, including the Sydney Opera House, the Royal Albert Hall and Carnegie Hall.

He has made eighteen recordings to date, ranging from quite traditional to fairly out there, and continues to explore the region where traditional music begins to disintegrate.

Caoimhín performs as a solo artist, yet is also widely known through his collaborative work, including groups The Gloaming and This is How we Fly, and duos with Dan Trueman, Thomas Bartlett, Garth Knox, Mick O'Brien and Brendan Begley. He has also performed with artists such as Laurie Anderson, Vincent Moon and Amiina.

Thit an domhain Gaelach as a chéile le linn saol Aodhagáin Ó Rathaille, agus bhí sé ar cheann de na príomh-thráchtairí ar an gcasadh cinniúnach seo i stair agus litríocht na hÉireann. Rugadh é le linn ré na mBard-Scoleanna agus fuair sé bás i mbochtanas le linn aimsir na bpéindlithe agus na goúirteanna filiochta. Bhí sé ar dhuine den dream a bhrúigh ar aghaidh leis an ngluaiseacht nua sa litríocht as a tháinig an Aisling, ceol an dóchais in aimsir an éadóchais.

Filíocht domhain, dána agus fíochmhar a scríobh an Rathailleach. Gile na Gile / Brightness of Brightness - The Music and Journeys of Aodhagáin Ó Rathaille

Composed and presented by **Lorcán Mac Mathúna** (voice),
Martin Tourish (accordion), and **Éamonn Galldubh** (pipes and flute).

The Gaelic world fell apart during the life of Aodhagáin Ó Rathaille, and he was one of the leading chroniclers of this traumatic turn in Irish history and literature. He was born during the era of the Bardic School but died in poverty during penal times and the times of the subverted Bardic Court. He was one of the chief generators of the new movement in literature which produced the Aisling: the music of hope during a hopeless first.

The Raitheallach wrote deep, bold and fierce poetry. His poetry was a savage witness to a brutal and tragic time, written with clarity and always an eye for beauty in words. He wrote lyrically, with musical rhythm and alliterative pathos. The most capable poet of a new era of Irish. A poet who has not yet been surpassed. With his *sui generis* writings in the newly evolving style of Irish poetry, it can be said that O Rathaille is the father of modern Irish literature.

Meascann an ceol tionchair ó cheol traidisiúnta na hÉireann agus traidisiún amhránaíochta an tsean-nóis, ceol snagcheoil/ceol saor-chumtha agus ceol clasaiceach comhaimseartha chun stil nuálach iarchineálach de cheol seomra comhaimseartha Éireannach a chruthú. Tá na ceoltóirí seo ar chuid de na ceoltóirí óga is mó meas in Éirinn sa lá atá inniu ann.

Immram is a suite of poems by Nuala Ní Dhomhnaill first published in her collection 'Feis' (1991). In 2019 Neil Ó Lochlainn was commissioned by Paddy Bushe and the Amergin Solstice Poetry Gathering to set the poems to music and the resulting suite of music was premiered at the festival in Waterville in 2021.

The music combines influences from Irish traditional music and the sean-nós singing tradition, jazz/improvised music and contemporary classical music to create an innovative post-genre style of contemporary Irish chamber music. The musicians are some of the most highly regarded young musicians in Ireland today.



'Immram' roughly translates as 'Voyage' and is a type of story found commonly in mythological Irish writing describing a protagonist's journey by sea to the otherworld and the adventures that ensue during their voyage.



Caoimhín Ó Fearghail comes from An Rinn in the Waterford Gaeltacht. He started to learn the tin-whistle at the age of eight, taking lessons from Bobby Gardiner. He quickly progressed to the uilleann pipes and is self-taught on flute and guitar.

It will be a wonderful source of inspiration to immerse myself in this vibrant cultural community and an immense joy to spend time working in such an artistic space and on such a beautiful and special piano.

*During my residency I will be exploring and comparing the soundworlds and melodic lines of two celebrated classical composers: **John Field and Chopin**. Famed for their lyricism, pianistic techniques and harmonic lines I will explore these composers alongside selected Irish melodies which I will arrange and perform in concert towards the end of my residency. Irish melodies undoubtedly inspired John Field who in turn inspired Chopin. Irish melodies are celebrated for their haunting beauty. Having grown up learning Irish folk songs and the Sean Nós style with my father I have always felt a strong and true relationship between the Irish melodies we know and love and the great masterpieces of the classical music world. This innate talent of Irish composers to create the most timeless melodies continues and I feel will forever more.*

*It is an immense honour to be invited to compose a special work for An Ionad Cultúrtha during my Residency. My concert will coincide with a wonderful art exhibition inspired by An Gaorthadh. The tragic story of this once thriving and beautiful oak forest is one which will never be forgotten. An Gaorthadh is not far from where my father grew up and I always remember being told about it as a child. The felling of so many trees that were centuries old and the relocating of many people who called this special area their home is heart breaking. The remaining stumps rising above the water is and forever will be a haunting reminder of this eternal devastation. The title of my composition inspired by The Gearagh is called **An Choill Chaille (The Lost Forest)**'*

In 2023 he was invited by the legendary Frankie Gavin to join his group Dé Dannan. They have played at multiple festivals in Ireland, UK and Europe.




Jackie Daly, Matt Cranitch & Paul de Grae

I 1989 d’fhoilsigh sé “Traditional Irish Guitar”, an chéad ábhar teagaisc dá leithéid, ath-eisithe ag Ossian i 1996 le dlúthdhiosca i dteannta leis. Jackie Daly, Matt Cranitch & Paul de Grae

Jackie Daly (accordion) The words ‘Button Accordion’ and ‘Jackie Daly’ are synonymous in the world of Irish traditional music. Described in the New York Times as “probably the best accordionist in Ireland”, Jackie was born in Kanturk, Co. Cork, surrounded by the rich music tradition of Sliabh Luachra. Jackie’s style and repertoire of the Sliabh Luachra tradition has made the most significant impression on his accordion-playing, a fact well exemplified through his performances and recordings. He has toured extensively and has also taught. In 2005, he received the TG4 Gradam Ceoil and, in 2009, the Kanturk Arts Festival Award.



Matt Cranitch (fiddle) is renowned as a fiddle-player and teacher, both at home in Ireland and abroad. He has performed extensively at concerts and festivals, on radio and television, and has presented lectures, master-classes and workshops on various aspects of Irish music.

He has won All-Ireland Fleadh Cheoil titles, as well as The Fiddler of Dooney and Oireachtas Crotty Cup. Author of *The Irish Fiddle Book*, first published in 1988 and now in its fourth edition, he has also contributed to other books on Irish traditional music.

He has received various accolades, including: University College Cork Hall of Fame Award in 2003; M.J. Quill Irish Cultural Center NY Award in 2014; Patrick O’Keeffe Traditional Music Festival Award in 2017; TG4 Gradam Saoil Award in 2025.

Paul de Grae (guitar) is a Dublin-born guitarist (and occasional singer), living in Kerry for many years. He has recorded with Jackie and Matt, The Smoky Chimney, Eoin Duignan, Paudie O’Connor and others. In 1989 he published “Traditional Irish Guitar”, the first such tutor, re-issued by Ossian in 1996 with a companion CD.

He has a particular interest in the music of Sliabh Luachra, plays regularly at sessions, concerts and festivals throughout Ireland and teaches guitar workshops in Ireland and the USA. He is engaged in an-ongoing research project on the music collector Francis O’Neill, and has written and lectured on the subject. He is a founder member of the North Kerry Traditional Music Archive.


