We are delighted to present our new musical creation, based on a major yet forgotten historical event : Irish immigration to Brittany. The show blends ancient and contemporary Irish and Breton repertoires.

On studying the work of historians Éamon Ó Ciosáin, Alain Le Noac'h and Patricia Dagier, we discovered that tens of thousands of Irish emigrated to Brittany during the 17th and 18th centuries, fleeing persecution by the English. This past naturally resonated with us, given our musical backgrounds, rooted in Breton and Irish music.

Véronique Bourjot teaches traditional singing such as jazz, Irish singing, classical and contemporary music and the educational Kanit ta bugale for children.

Brewen Favrau has a background in classical music. After learning to play the uilleann pipes, having spent several years in Ireland. Brewen has collaborated with Scottish, Irish and Breton musicians on his musical travels.

Soazig Hamelin Born into a family of Breton musicians. Her fiddle and voice have supported Beoga, Aidan Coffey, Colm Murphy and Calum Stewart.

Kevin Le Pennec hails from Brest. He perfected his instrumental skills with Nikolaz Cadoret and was introduced to French traditional song by Marc Clérvit. Kevin is a singer-songwriter.

The film features the remarkable love stories of three Deaf couples: a Deaf boxer and his hearing partner facing a life-altering choice; a same-sex

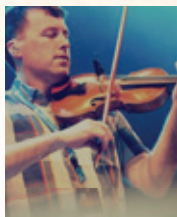

Is bheidhleadóir ó Ráth Luirc é **Liam Flanagan** ó dhúchas. Le linn a óige bhíodh sé go minic ag seinnt i dteannta Craobh Chrónáin CCE i gCillín an Chrónáin. Faoi láthair, bíonn sé ag seinnt go rialta le North Cregg, Danú, agus tá turasanna ceolmhara tabhartha aige ar an Eoraip agus ar na Stáit.

Tagann **Caoimhín Ó Fearghail** ó cheantar na Rinne i nGaeltacht Phort Láirge. Thosnaigh sé ag foghlaim na feadóige stáin ag aois ocht mbliana, agus bhog sé ón bhfeadóig go dtí na píopaí uileann agus é féin-mhúinte ar an bhflúit agus ar an ngiotár chomh maith. Bhuaigh Caoimhín Gradam Ceoil TG4 Ceoltóir Óg na Bliana sa bhliain 2012.

Aithnítear **Derek Hickey**, ó Áth Dara go forleathan mar cheann des na boscadóirí is fearr in Éirinn. Thosaigh sé ag seinnt leis an Shannonside Céilí Band ansin le Arcady - in éineacht le Frances Black, Brendan Larrisey agus Patsy Broderick agus ina dhiaidh sin Dé Dannan.

Nell Ní Chróinín hails from the Béal Átha'n Ghaorthaidh. Nell was exposed to local singing traditions from a very young age. She was the youngest ever recipient to receive 'TG4's Gradam Ceoil Traditional Singer of the Year' award in 2012 and the prestigious Corn Uí Riada award in 2014. She is currently the lead singer in the well-renowned traditional band, Danú.

Liam Flanagan is a fiddle player originally from Charleville. He grew up playing as part of Craobh Cronain CCE in Freemount, Co. Cork and now regularly performs with North Cregg, Danu having toured across Europe and the USA.

Caoimhín Ó Fearghail from An Rinn in the Waterford Gaeltacht. He started to learn the tin-whistle at the age of eight. He quickly progressed to the uilleann pipes and is self-taught on flute and guitar. Caoimhín was the 2012 recipient of the TG4 Young Musician of the Year award (Gradam Ceoil TG4).

Derek Hickey, from Adare, is widely acknowledged as one of Ireland's most prominent and influential master accordion players. At a young age he joined the Shannonside Céilí Band then Arcady, along with Frances Black, Brendan Larrisey and Patsy Broderick and then joined De Dannan.

McCarthy, a Cork-based pianist, keyboardist and composer, has worked widely as a session musician and is also a member of NOTIFY.
